The Sursock Museum’s permanent collection consists of works acquired by or donated to the museum since it first opened in 1961. The collection is mainly composed of paintings, graphic works, sculptures, and other three-dimensional objects.

An additional section is dedicated to recent acquisitions and donations, to be exhibited in rotation.
